

Changes to Journalism Units

A number of improvements have been made to the undergraduate suite of Journalism courses and units, effective semester 1, 2013. Continuing students should consult this table when enrolling.

Change to Advanced Journalism minors (AVAILABLE TO SINGLE DEGREE STUDENTS ONLY)

From 2013, both the **Radio, Television and Print Journalism Practice Minor** and **Online and Print Journalism Minor** will no longer be available for selection. Continuing students who have selected these minors will be able to complete them.

A new **ADVANCED JOURNALISM MINOR** is available for all new students, and students who have not selected a specialised Journalism minor.

Unit name changes

KJB101 - renamed Computational Journalism (from Digital Journalism). If you have successfully completed Digital Journalism, you are not required to complete Computation Journalism.

KJB337 - renamed to Investigative Reporting (from Public Affairs Reporting). If you have successfully completed Public Affairs Reporting, you are not required to complete Investigative Reporting.

Changes to availabilities (NOTE: CHANGES TO SEMESTER OF OFFER REPRESENT THE SINGLE DEGREE)

KPB101 Introduction to Film, TV and New Media has been relocated from **YEAR 2, Semester 1, to YEAR 1 Semester 1**. If you have not completed this unit, you will be required to select it at your next available opportunity.

KJB280 International Journalism has been relocated from **YEAR 3, Semester 2 optional unit to a CORE YEAR 3, Semester 1 unit**. If you have not completed this unit, you will be required to select it at your next available opportunity. If you have nominated either the **Radio, Television and Print Journalism Practice Minor** or the **Online and Print Journalism Practice Minor**, International Journalism will remain an option for you.

KJB304 Sub-Editing has been relocated **from YEAR 3, Semester 1 to YEAR 2, Semester 1**. If you have not completed this unit, you will be required to select it at your next available opportunity.

KCB103 Strategic Speech Communication is *no longer part of the course* . If you have successfully completed this unit, it will remain on your Study Plan.

KCB102 Media Myth Busting 1 has been relocated from the core program to an optional unit within the new **Advanced Journalism Minor**.

KJB211 Layout and Design has been discontinued and is being replaced with a new unit **KJB103 Media Design and Layout**. If you have not yet completed KJB211 and were expecting to, please select KJB103 Media Design and Layout. KJB103 is the new required unit in Journalism.

KJB104 Photojournalism is a new optional unit. It is an equivalent to KKB020 Applied Photography. If you have completed KKB020, you will not be able to enrol in KJB104.

KKB175 Creative Industries Legal Issues has been discontinued and is replaced by **LWS011 Journalism Law**. If you have completed KKB175, you do not have to complete LWS011. However, if you planned on completing KKB175 in 2013, you should now enrol in LWS011. The unit is a required unit in Journalism.
